Proactive Prevention

- Provided by all
- Look at academic, attendance, and office discipline referrals, universal SEL screeners, to identify students who need to move to next Tier.

#### Tier 2

Interventions for about 15%

- IO-I2 weeks
- May need multiple interventions
- May be provided by the student support team (school counselor, social worker, nurse, mental health counselor, teacher, special education team)
- Look at data (student outcome, specific intervention data, etc.) to determine next steps

## Tier 3

Individual Interventions for about 5%  Provided by mental health counselor, outside community resource, special education team, and in some instances school counselors
