for about 15%

- Classroom lessons
- Workshops, training, and resources for caregivers
- Peace/calm corners in the classroom
- School-wide events like College/Career Days
- Professional development for all staff
- Develop school-wide expectations
- Provide additional classroom supports like mini SEL lessons
- School-wide initiatives
- Community partnerships
- Whole child appraisal/ Universal screeners

HS Example Tiered Level of Support

Across all Tiers we Define, Manage, Deliver, and Assess!

- Collaborate with graduation coaches
- Consider IEP/504 accommodation
- BIP/FBA
- Refer to school psychologist
- Refer to mental health counselor

Tier 3 Intense Interventions

- Caregiver/student workshop to explore post-graduation plans/options, testing, and FAFSA
- Implement CTE organizations
- Study groups for students struggling in particular academic classes/areas
- Small group services
- Mentorship programs for chronically absent students

Tier 2 Targeted Interventions

- Collaborate with community businesses for internship opportunities
- Collaborate with local universities about college credit opportunities
- Establish a school counselor advisory team
- Provide school-wide instruction

- Provided by all
- Look at academic, attendance, and office discipline referrals, universal SEL screeners, to identify students who need to move to next Tier.

Tier 2

Interventions
for about 15%

- 10-12 weeks
- May need multiple interventions
- May be provided by the student support team (school counselor, social worker, nurse, mental health counselor, teacher, special education team)
- Look at data (student outcome, specific intervention data, etc.) to determine next steps

Tier 3

Individual
Interventions for
about 5%

- Provided by mental health counselor, outside community resource, special education team, and in some instances school counselors
